

The Rules of The Batchwood Hall Bowling Club 100 Club

DEFINITIONS

The Club – Batchwood Hall Bowling Club

100 Club – The small lottery on behalf of Batchwood Hall Bowling Club

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds for Batchwood Hall Bowling Club.

RULES

1. The 100 Club is open to all members and friends of The Club over 16 years of age.
2. The subscription to the 100 Club for one number will be £2 per month, payable via either a monthly standing order or annual payment in advance into the named bank account. This will give members one number which will be placed in a monthly draw. Members may have and are encouraged to have multiple subscriptions.
3. Contributors will be allocated a number between 1 and 100. Numbers will be allocated on a first come first served basis and members will retain the same number for as long as their membership is active.
4. Monthly draws will take place from April to March (12 per year)
5. A monthly draw will take place with 3 prizes, based on the money paid into the 100 Club the same month, of 20%, 10% and 5% for first, second and third places respectively. However, the draw in November will be a Super Draw and the 3 prizes will be 50%, 25% and 15% of the money paid into the 100 Club for that month.
6. In the case where a number is drawn that has not been sold, the number will be redrawn until a winning number is drawn.
7. Payments must be made by the specified date each month. This will be dependent on the date set for the draw and will be announced to the 100 Club members in advance.
8. Members numbers will only be entered if they have paid and accepted these terms and conditions.
9. The draw dates will take place on different dates each month depending on the nominated event at which the draw has been assigned to be made. All these dates will be published on the Club website in addition to all 100 Club members being notified.
10. The draw will be made either by selecting the number from a bag or by using a true random number generator (random.org) and will be made in the presence of at least three other people.
11. Winners will be contacted soon after the draw to arrange payment of winnings.
12. The winning numbers will be posted to the Club website. The names of members and winners will only be announced if they approve, this approval can be withdrawn at any time by contacting the 100 Club Promoter.
13. The 100 Club will be run by the Promoter and in case of any dispute the decision of the Promoter is final.
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be forfeited after three months from the date the draw takes place.
